- ❖ The grand finale of Family Feud will take place at this time.

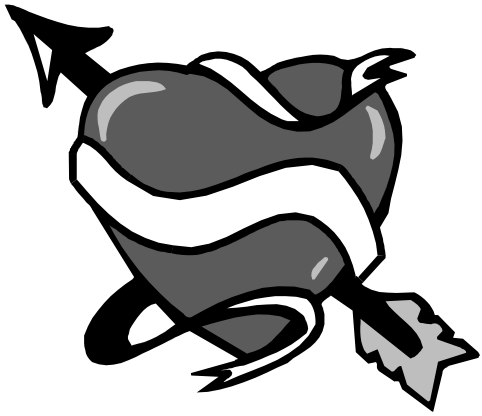
